Guide for Project Approval

- 1. Send to the Diocesan Facility Director a description of the project, regardless of the size and amount of the project.
 - Please consult the Guidelines and Protocols for the Design and Renovation of Churches and Chapels booklet for major projects.
 - Approval is required for all projects that have a <u>total cost</u> greater than \$10,000 or that involve any changes to the worship space, roof, boiler, or schools. There is no \$15,000 limit for projects at this time.
 - The maximum amount a pastor can spend for acts of extraordinary administration without seeking advice of his Finance Committee at the lesser of 5% of Sunday and Holy Day Collections or \$10,000.
 - Any building or grounds improvement, major repair, or demolition or construction exceeding \$10,000 must have the approval of both the parish Finance Council and the Bishop.
- 2. Arrange a site visit by Diocese Facility Director.
- 3. Submit letter to Bishop asking permission to proceed with seeking bids.
- 4. Submit project specifications or architect of choice to be approved by Diocese Facility Director.
- 5. Submit a minimum of three (3) bids. Include a letter of recommendation along with all of the bids to the Diocese for Building Commission. The Building Commission will make a recommendation to Bishop.
- 6. Await letter from Bishop for approval to begin project. *Do not proceed until approval letter has been received.*
