Once promulgated by Bishop Cistone, this document will be introduced to the parishes in a number of regional catechetical workshops. These guidelines will affect the formation of all liturgical ministers and the management of those ministers within the Diocese. Our hope is that these guidelines and workshops will be a valuable means of supporting parishes in the formation and ongoing renewal of liturgical ministers.
